Agent Orange - issue and Legislation:

HR 812/S. 1629 - Agent Orange Equity Act of 2011, HR 2634 Victims of Agent Orange Relief Act of 2011 The current ship list can be found at <u>http://www.publichealth.va.gov/exposures/agentorange/</u>. Most Blue Water Navy ships are not yet – included in the list, unless they made certain port calls or actions inland, however, there are several studies and legislation that indicates exposure to off shore ships in the Vietnam War. AUSN is keeping a very close watch on the updated list & this issue; we support S 1629 and HR 2634. You can see how to add to the list the above web page. Meetings on Your Behalf:

Senator Inouye – I had the opportunity to meet with the Senator and his staff on several issues. His perspective is well respected on both sides of Congress. As a Medal of Honor recipient, statesman, and as Chair of the powerful Appropriations Committee – he knows what you the veteran, the active duty, the Reservist, survivor, retiree are. Senator Pryor – staff: In a meeting with staff of Senator Pryor – we have recommended some possible amendments to the FY 2012 – NDAA; if Congress does get the bill to the floor – we hope to get some of our legislative goals passed.

Veterans Affairs: Veterans Day. A celebratory concert is planned for 10 November, as well as the following; 11 Nov; Arlington Cemetery Ceremony, Laying of Wreath at the Tomb of Unkown, and a reception on behalf of all Veterans on 11 NOV. See next month's magazine for legislation to support.

TMC Award Ceremony: Executive Director & National President – attended TMC Awards Ceremony – where Congressman Tim Walz (D-MN) and his MLA – Brian Kessler – where awarded TMC's highest legislative awards. TMC Guard and Reserve Committee Meeting; As Co-Chair of this committee – AUSN chairs the meeting, and provides guidance to 15 association on strategy and approach to Congress with our legislative goals. This month, we are focusing on Joint Committee on Deficit Reductions, TFL, HR 1025 & S 491, NDAA passage, & the Clark Veterans Cemetery. NMVA Meetings: This coalition is 35 associations working for the advancement of Veterans and their families. We focus on Veterans issues. Recently members of the NMVA wrote to the Joint Committee on Deficit Reduction and asked for extreme caution when considering any more cuts to the Defense budget, and you can find us at <u>www.nmva.us</u>.

AUSN Director of Government Affairs – attended the AUSA Conference and Symposium 11-12 OCT, where over 300+ businesses and associations where present. SECDEF Panetta, Sec of the Army, and military leadership all provided their perspective on current deficit reductions – stating that these cuts would hurt our National Security. Military Health Care was a major point of discussion.

Clark Veterans Cemetery – Clark, RP -- Please write Congress in support of making Clark Veterans Cemetery – a USG controlled cemetery again. <u>www.cvcra.org</u>. We are supporters and an Ally of an effort to bring formerly Clark AFB cemetery back under the control of the USG. Clark was closed due partly to Mt. Pinatubo eruption in 1992. There are over 8,500 veterans, most wartime, buried at this cemetery – the cemetery was abandoned. See full details <u>www.cvcra.org</u>.
